What is St. John Bosco Youth Education for Children with Special Needs?

- We have many children in our parish who have special learning needs. This ministry looks to take each child where they are at and provide religious education that will meet the individual needs for children between the ages of kindergarten to 18 years old.
- This program has lead catechists that have experience and some training to work with children with special needs, and the small group leaders and catechists will be provided with training and resources.
- Our program is geared for students who have intellectual disability.

What will the program provide?

- A curriculum based off of the catechism that is appropriate for their learning needs.
- Sacramental formation will be provided to all students that need 1st reconciliation, 1st communion, and confirmation.
- A place to grow through prayer, community, and to develop a deeper relationship with God.

First Communion & Reconciliation:

This is a 2 year (minimum*) preparation program for students in 1st and 2nd grade or any students who are older and haven't received these sacraments yet.

Confirmation:

This is a 3 year (minimum*) program for students currently in middle school who have received 1st communion and reconciliation. Confirmation will take place in high school.

Religious Education:

This is for students who are not in a sacramental prep year. Students will learn about their Catholic faith through Bible stories, games, interactive lessons, prayer, praise and worship, and sensory activities.

*We take students where they are at. We believe every student is able to learn about their faith at their level and receive their sacraments. We want students to understand to the best of their abilities and not just go through the motions.
